

Scotus Mothers Meeting Minutes

Minutes: The minutes of the October and November meetings were reviewed by those present. The minutes was motioned by Kris Wurtz and seconded by Kelly Feehan. The minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report: The beginning balance at September 1st was \$36,356.15 and the ending balance at December 31st was \$37,610.25. It was mentioned that it would be nice when filling out a deposit slip if it would be indicated what the deposit is for example apparel. This statement does not include a bill for the new items that was purchased to sell. The Treasurer's report was motioned by Symantha Aydt and seconded by Jane Cline for approval. The Treasurer's report was approved.

Old Business: Craft Boutique – no members were present to give a final wrap up due to conflicts in their schedules but once again it was a good year for the boutique by looking at the deposits. It was talked about giving the past Boutique Committee members a lifetime pass to attend the Boutique for all of the work they did for it.

It was mentioned that they still need 2 people to shadow for kitchen duties and 1 person to shadow for the boutique for 2018. This item will be followed up with the committee.

Nicole Blaser was unable to attend the meeting as she was on the Right to Life trip to Washington DC to discuss the Academic Recognition breakfast.. She did give Kris Wurtz an update on what she had done for it and was looking for some additional input from Scotus Mothers and some Moms to help with the breakfast. Nicole did a wonderful job putting all of this together. It was decided to allow \$750 from Scotus Mothers to purchase the food, drinks, and paper products for this event.

New Business: Fund raising was next on the agenda. It was stated that the new items are selling well. However, there is some older merchandise that really needs to be sold. Ideas were talked about on how to sell the older items.

Scotus Mothers are to receive 7% payback from BSN sales. Kelly Feehan is going to check on this item.

The next item was for donations from Scotus Mothers. Post prom asked for a donation and it was approved to donate \$125 to Post Prom.

Scotus Mothers are also going to donate a Stadium chair for the silent auction for the Gala.

Kelly Feehan then talked about the wish list for the teachers. Like for last year the teachers will have to fill out a form and explain their wish and how it will be maintained. It was decided the form will be handed out to the teachers this year instead of being emailed to them.
