

Scotus Mothers Meeting Minutes
March 21, 2018
Held at the Chamber of Commerce

Present: Kelly Feehan, Jane Cline, Kris Wurtz, Sym Aydt, Nicole Blaser, Pat Engel, and Jeff Ohnoutka.

Minutes: The minutes of the February meeting was reviewed by those present. The minutes was motioned by Nicole Blaser and seconded by Sym Aydt. The minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Tammy Bichlmeier was not present for the meeting and there was not a printed financial report but the balance in the account is \$36,800.80.

Staff "Wish" List: Mr. Ohnoutka was present to ask for an annual donation from Scotus Mothers in the amount of \$5,000.00 that will be matched from the budget at Scotus for the STEAM project. He stated that if Scotus Mothers wanted to ear tag the money for something specific he didn't have a problem with it. They have raised \$296,000 for the STEAM. He stated that they will be buying approximately \$12,000 of science equipment and will need furniture and computers. The STEAM project already has many good ideas and one is to start a T-shirt screen printing project. A motion was made by Nicole Blaser and seconded by Jane Cline to donate \$5,000 a year to the STEAM Project. The motion carried.

Mr. Ohnoutka then spoke a little bit about the facilities at Scotus and asked for any input from Scotus Mothers. It was then discussed that maybe Scotus Mothers could maybe give a small gift to the teachers and workers at Scotus as an appreciation gift.

Staff "Wish" List – There were 5 applications received for Scotus Mothers to review. Carmen. Johnson asked for \$160 for an Air Fryer and an Instant Pot. Kelly Koranda asked for \$470 for a classroom set of Bibles for Religion 9 & 10, Bridget McPhillips asked for \$1,200 for ipads for Earth Science and Physical Science. Melanie Mimick asked for \$330 for ipad for Extemporaneous Speaking Prep at Speech competitions. Tyler Linder, Janet Tooley, Tyler Swanson and Zach McPhillips asked for \$500 for hardware for plt4m (platform) for the weight room and PE. All requests listed above were approved with a note added to the PE teachers request that this would be available for all students, all athletes, and including power lifting.

Craft Boutique – Pat Engel gave the prices for new commercial grade roasters and coffee pots. The roasters are \$85 each and coffee pots are \$95 each. A motion was made by Nicole Blaser and seconded by Jane Cline to buy 2 roasters and 2 coffee pots. The motion carried.

Pat mentioned that they are still looking for 2 committee volunteers.

Merchandise: Kris is going to try and sell some older merchandise at the Alumni tournament on March 23rd and 24th. They will be doing a summer inventory going through everything and deciding what to do with some of the older items. Some of the excess merchandise will be given to Post Prom for gifts.
